Update the current regional planetary strategy Nature Step to Health and create the IAP as the detailed **city strategy** of this.

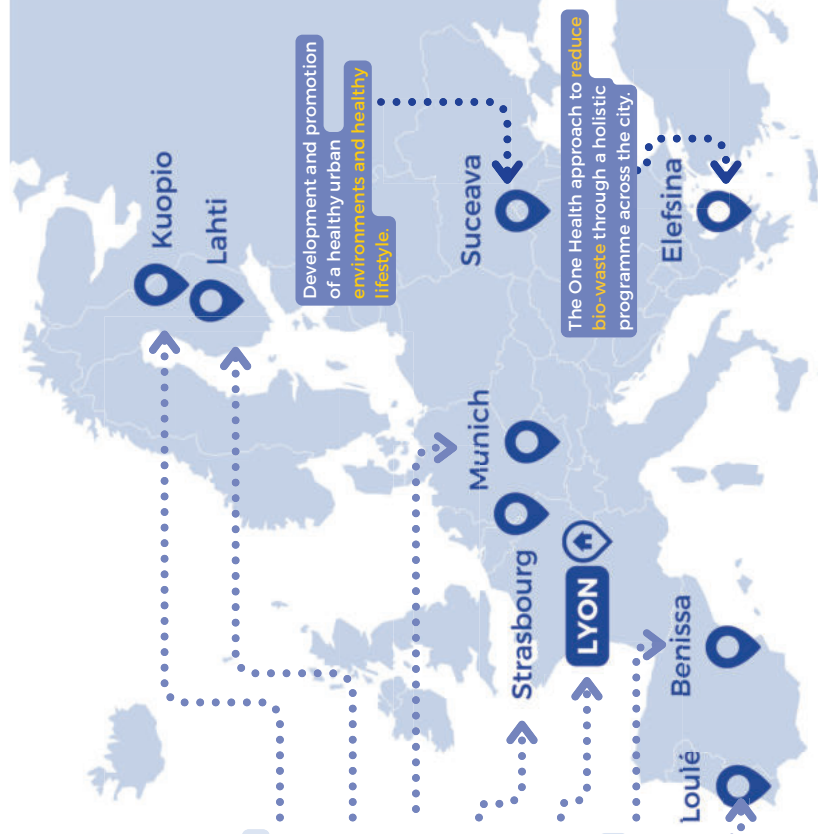
Integration of the One Health approach into the **city health strategy**, named "Health Guideline".

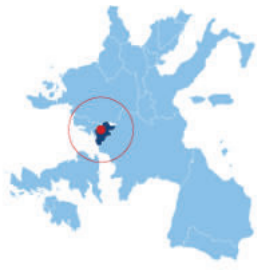

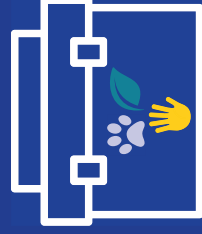

One Health Role Play for Cities:

- Allows participants to take on the roles of a plant, human, animal, or ecosystem.
- Players collaborate and negotiate to address challenges and opportunities in urban planning while considering the interconnectedness and co-existence in an urban area.
- Fosters creative problem-solving, empathy, and a deeper understanding of the One Health

**HOW TO PLAY IN 3 STEPS (one way to play,
you can invent yours)**

6 to 8 persons on a table

1. Participants identify 3 conditions under which an urban environment will protect its well-being & health
2. Participants present their conditions and they start organizing them
3. Participants discuss and must find a way to present together (in 2/3 sentences maximum) a vision of a future city that respects health and well-being of all the components.
